## TIMBER VENEER

### Veneer

Our Timber Veneers are a thin slice of real timber attached to MDF board, with a total thickness of 17mm. The veneer panel has 1 Good Side and 1 Downgrade Back Side. This means that both sides will have real timber on, however they will not be identical and only the good side is suitable as a front.

Like other natural and batch manufactured products, veneers from the same timber species can vary greatly in colour & pattern. Product images should be used as a general reference only.

Your items will likely be cut from different sheets and may not align or match exactly, as patterns and colours will vary from sheet to sheet.

Veneers are for indoor and dry area applications only.

**Finish:** Our Veneers are provided unsealed. This allows the customer to finish off as they like. This can include oiling, lacquering, staining or clear coating with polyurethane.

## Care Instructions

Treat your Veneer items as you would any real timber product.

When cleaning your veneer items, use a damp soft cloth, with no abrasive or commercial cleaning chemicals. Do not use a scourer as this may scratch the surface. Always & immediately dry water from the surfaces with a clean dry cloth.

Avoid hot items coming into direct contact with the veneer as this may cause discoloration.

Light exposure can cause the veneer to fade over time. Where possible, we recommend that all veneer surfaces be exposed to the same amount of light, as different exposure can lead to different wear & coloration.

It is recommended to seal your veneer products to avoid watermarks and help with longevity.

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
